1 Section 1. Section 134 of the civil service law is amended by adding a

- 2 new subdivision 8 to read as follows:
- 3 8. (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section or of any
- 4 other law, including article fourteen of this chapter, or collective
- 5 bargaining agreement or other analogous contract or binding interest
- 6 arbitration award, the work week of officers and employees of the execu-
- 7 tive branch, including temporary and seasonal employees under article
- 8 fourteen of this chapter, shall be subject to reduction by one-fifth as
- 9 further provided in this subdivision. Such work week reduction shall not
- 10 apply to essential officers and employees or to employees and officers
- 11 designated as managerial or confidential pursuant to article fourteen of
- 12 this chapter.
- 13 (b) For the purpose of this subdivision, "essential officers and
- 14 employees" shall mean any state employees of the executive branch who
- 15 serve in a position responsible for providing direct care or certain
- 16 security services as determined by the director of the budget to be
- 17 necessary for the preservation of public health or safety.
- 18 (c) The work week reduction shall be scheduled during the period
- 19 commencing May tenth and ending May fourteenth, two thousand ten as
- 20 determined by the appointing authority of each agency in order to maxi-
- 21 mize the efficiency and effectiveness of the agency's operations. The
- 22 appointing authority shall ensure that every employee and every officer
- 23 who is not exempted pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subdivision is
- 24 scheduled for such work week reduction. Appointing authorities shall
- 25 not authorize additional overtime in conjunction with work week
- 26 reductions.
- 27 (d) In no event shall an officer or employee whose work week is
- 28 reduced pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subdivision be permitted to

- 1 offset any reduction in wages or salary through the utilization of any
- 2 accrued leave credits.
- 3 § 2. Section 200 of the state finance law is amended by adding a new
- 4 subdivision 2-c to read as follows:
- 5 2-c. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the wages and sala-
- 6 ries paid to employees whose work week was reduced pursuant to subdivi-
- 7 sion eight of section one hundred thirty-four of the civil service law
- 8 shall be reduced by the same percentage reduction that was made to the
- 9 employee's work schedule during the relevant payroll period.
- 10 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall expire and be
- 11 deemed repealed March 31, 2011.
